We would like to invite your guild to sell tickets for and display an opportunity / fund raising quilt at the 31st Annual Pennsylvania National Quilt Extravaganza. This event draws thousands of quilters to the festival and is an excellent fund-raising event. Pennsylvania National Quilt Extravaganza will provide your guild with space to display your raffle quilt for all four days of the festival in exchange for a total of 32 hours of white glove volunteer service. Volunteers have the option of filling eight (8) four- hour shifts, or sixteen (16) two-hour shifts. Please note that all volunteers must pay either the pre-registration fee or the general admission so that they have proper identification to enter the show area, and we ask that all volunteers supply their own white gloves. (Quilts must be displayed all days of show and must be set-up on Wednesday 9/12/25.)
